Skills, qualifications and experience required

You need to have minimum of 3 years of post-qualification medical practice experience, specialising in general practice, general internal medicine or accident & emergency. Furthermore, the candidate must have the ability to provide guidance and advice to students, requiring sound managerial skills and knowledge in the area of general medicine and/or A&E. It is also required for the candidate to have the capacity to act as a clinical mentor and be flexible to adapt to new environments, especially with resource poor settings.
